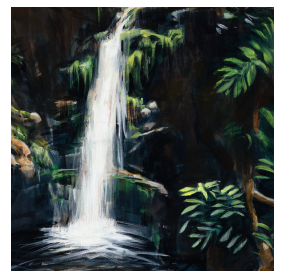
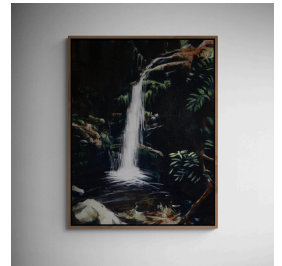




My Sister's Keeper
