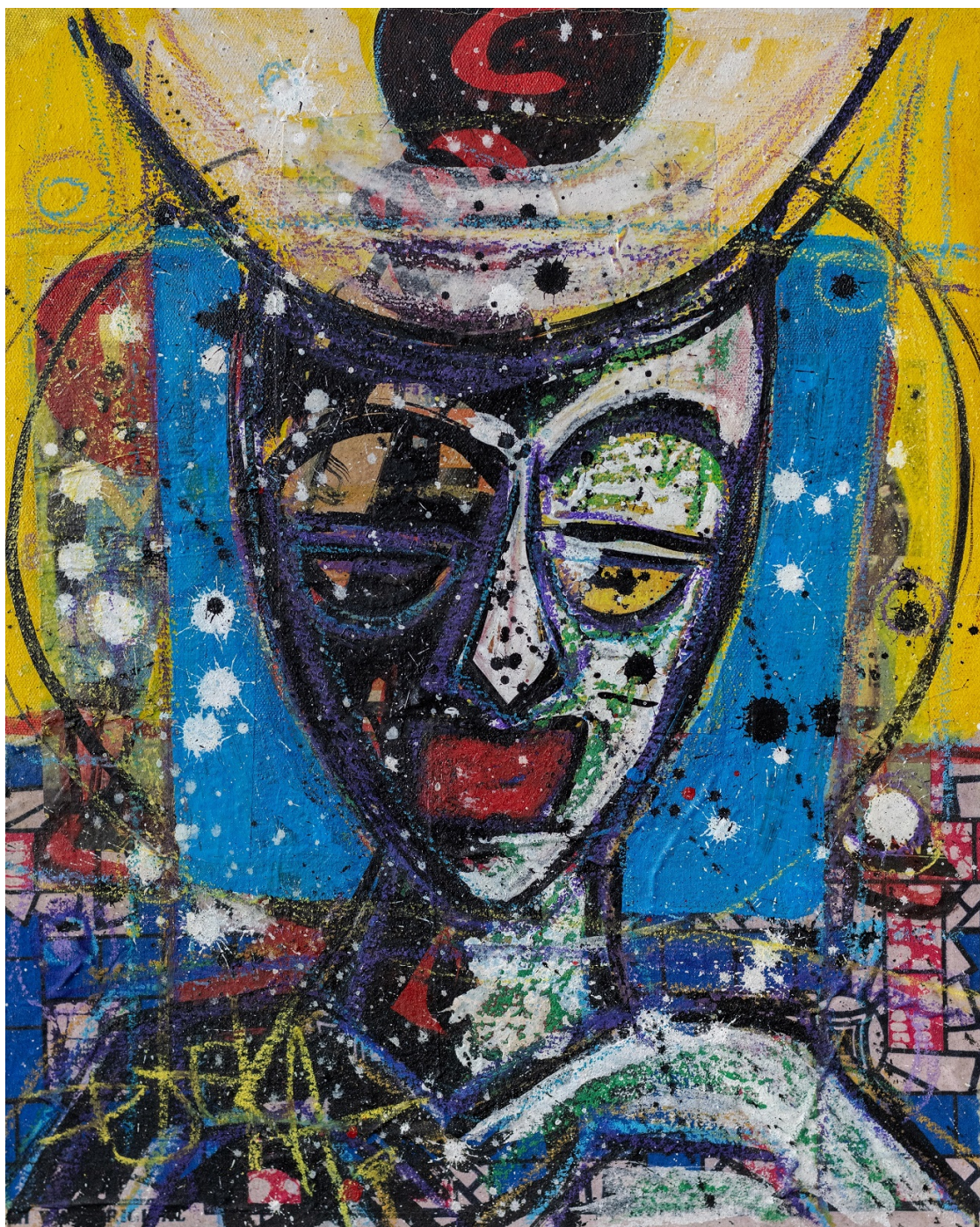




Jomeaux Celeste I
