In pursuance of Section VIII of Act No. 14 of 1878, I hereby notified for general information, that the following pieces of Crown Land, situate in the Division of Prince Albert, will be offered for sale, by Public Auction, in front of the Office of the Civil Commissioner at Prince Albert, at 10 o'clock a.m. on Wednesday, 11th August, 1886, subject to the conditions and stipulations hereinafter mentioned, and further to such conditions as may be published on the day of Sale.
There will be two sums as marked (a) and (b) in the Lots hereto attached, reserved on the Lots as Annual Rents for different terms of years, viz:—
The Upset Rent (a) for a Lease for a term of one year, and the Rent (b) for a term of three years.
The sum bid be the Rent (a) or a larger sum than the Rent (b), the Lease shall be for a term of three years only.
If the sum be nearer in amount to Rent (b) than to Rent (a), the Lease may be for a term of not less than one year and not exceeding two years, and the Rent (b) or any greater amount be offered the Lease may be for any term not less than one year and not exceeding three years.
The following are the General Conditions of all such Leases:—

The Government reserves the right of cancelling the Lease, should it be thought necessary or expedient at any time, at its discretion; and in such case the proportion of any sum paid by the Lessee shall be returned to the Lessee.
All taxes and rates levied on the land, and the salaries of the surveyors and assistants employed in the surveying of the land, shall be paid by the Lessee, and the right of
